

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

NFPS prepared the plans and bid package for this Small County Road Assistance Program (SCRAP) resurfacing project in north Baker County. The project included widening and resurfacing the existing two-lane rural highway, guardrail upgrades, drainage structure extensions, and pavement markings and signs.

The management approach was to address the primary intent of the project (widen the lanes and resurface the pavement) and to address specific safety upgrades. NFPS coordinated with FDOT on their future bridge replacement project to be sure we didn't spend unnecessary funds on the bridge that would just be torn out a few years later. NFPS worked with Mr. Fletcher to save money by having the County provide the drainage pipe, which helped to get the project bid under the funding allocation.
