

HERLONG STREET TRANSPORTATION ENGINEERING

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Herlong Street, in southern Columbia County, is a two-lane rural collector road that serves as an important East-West corridor. The County has planned to reconstruct the paving of this dirt road in two (2) phases.

NFPS provided the design and permitting for the road reconstruction of SW Herlong Street to convert the existing 4.1 mile dirt road to a paved road with improved drainage and shoulders. Other major items of work included major earthwork, drainage structures, and base and asphalt construction.
