



## SW 59TH DRIVE TRANSPORTATION ENGINEERING

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

SW 59th Drive in south central Hamilton County is a two-lane rural collector road that serves as an important East-West corridor connecting CR 158 at two (2) points creating a loop.

NFPS provided the design and permitting for the widening and resurfacing to convert 1.72 miles of the existing dirt road to a paved road and improved drainage and resurface 1.87 miles of existing paved road.

### TOTAL CONTRACT FUNDING

The total FDOT contract amount for this Small County Outreach Program (SCOP) funded project including design, construction, and inspection was approximately:
