



DOWLING PARK LIBRARY SITE DEVELOPMENT ENGINEERING

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project included the preparation of plans to construct a new Dowling Park Library Branch of the Suwannee River Regional Library System that included an approximately 5,000 SF building, as well as an additional 1,500 SF Archive Room. The library provides a spacious stack area for volumes of books, conference rooms, reading rooms for the patrons, as well as offices and a work room.

NFPS provided the architectural drawings, building plans that included electrical, plumbing, and HVAC plans, structural engineering, site plan engineering design, permitting, bidding, and construction engineering inspection services necessary to complete the project. NFPS also provided the schematic design documents through construction documents for permitting, bidding, and construction of the Dowling Park Library Project.
